What does this mean for your business?

What's new in Stage 3:

- › Businesses are no longer required to create defined spaces or areas for customers in their business.
- › There is no specific customer cap for businesses – the number allowed is determined by the size of your business and the 4 square metre rule.
- › For smaller venues below 200 square metres, businesses can have one person per 2 square metres up to 50 persons at a time.
- › Saunas, bathhouses (including floatation tanks) and non-therapeutic massage can re-open in Stage 3 using a COVID Safe Checklist.
- › More events will be allowed under the Framework for COVID Safe Events, events with:
 - › fewer than 500 people – no approval needed when following a COVID Safe Event Checklist
 - › 500 to 10,000 people – need a COVID Safe Event Plan approved by local public health units
 - › Over 10,000 people – need a COVID Safe Event Plan approved by the Queensland Chief Health Officer.

COVID Safe Business Framework

The COVID Safe Business Framework introduced in Stage 2, continues to apply. The framework provides guidance on your business's obligations and responsibilities in ensuring you keep your business, staff and customers safe.

If any of the COVID Safe Plans below apply to your business or industry you are required to operate in accordance with it.

› COVID Safe Checklists

COVID Safe Checklists were created for high-risk businesses to be able to operate safely during Stage 1 or 2. These checklists continue to apply in Stage 3, now with a limit of 50 customers.

› COVID Safe Industry Plans

COVID Safe Industry Plans were created in consultation with industry and union representatives for businesses that were reflected on the Roadmap. These approved COVID Safe Industry Plans will be updated to ensure consistency with the commencement of Stage 3.

› COVID Safe Site-Specific Plans

The application of these plans is limited to large and unique sites. If your business follows a COVID Safe Site-Specific Plan, this remains in force in Stage 3.

› Framework for COVID Safe Events

A Framework for COVID Safe Events is a new addition to the COVID Safe Business Framework. This has been developed for Stage 3 and is available on the COVID19 website.
