

Rail Tourism COVID Safe Requirements

Activity	New Restrictions from Monday 1 February 2021
Point to point and Round trip Tourism Rail operators (For trips up to 5 hours without disembarking the train)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Up to 100% of indoor seated capacity provided passengers are in ticketed and allocated seating, except the kiosk (e.g. food and beverage kiosk) where passengers must maintain 1.5 metres physical distancing in these areas. Operators must also manage the outdoor/shared spaces to allow for 1.5 metres physical distancing to the extent possible, this would include arrival/departure areas, group staging areas. <p>OR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">No more than one person per 2 square metres for areas open to or used by guests or patrons, whether indoors or outdoors; at all times.Observe 1.5 metres physical distancing to the extent possible.

Notes:

- Rail tourism businesses currently operate under strict health and safety requirements, including keeping detailed passenger manifests. They offer a primarily outdoors tourism experience.
